The No-No Boys tells the story of a Japanese-American boy interned at Tule Lake Relocation Center.

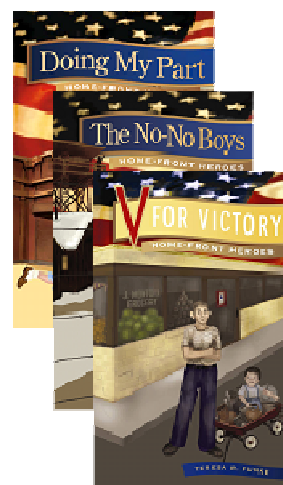
V for Victory is about 12-year-old Miguel Montoya who feels left out of the war until he meets a wounded veteran who needs his help.
